GENERAL RULES

All entries must be in writing, signed by owner or authorized agent, and accompanied by proper fees. Parent or guardian must sign the entry of a junior exhibitor.

NO OPEN CHECKS WITH ORGINIAL ENTRIES

Check policy; OPEN CHECKS will not be accepted with original entries. Full payment for classes entered and Office fees must accompany all entries. Exhibitors wishing to add classes during the show may leave an OPEN CHECK (separate from their entry fees) at the show office. Scratched classes will not be deducted from any applicable fees. CHECKS RETURNED, for any reason, will be assessed a \$25.00 processing fee.

Exhibitors canceling entries after closing date shall forfeit their entry fee except in case of disability of horse or rider. Entry fees will be refunded (less office fee) only upon presentation to the Show Secretary a Certificate of Disability from a qualified Veterinarian/Physician PRIOR TO THE FIRST CLASS THE HORSE/RIDER IS ENTERED.

Every class offered which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current Washington State Horsemen, Inc. Rulebook will be conducted and judged in accordance with current NWBZ rules.

The decision of the judge is final. No one shall approach the judge with regard to a decision unless he first obtains permission from the show committee & steward, who shall arrange an appointment at a proper time and place.

Veterinarian will be on call and phone number will be posted in the office. All Vet calls are subject to payment when services are rendered.

Protest must be in writing, signed and addressed to the show secretary, received by the show manager within 48 hours of the occurrence of the alleged violation and be accompanied by a \$50.00 deposit, which is forfeited if the objection is not sustained.

No dogs allowed on the show grounds unless leased. Loose dogs will be impounded and a fee of \$25.00 will be charged to release the dog.

The NWBZ, BB Stablemates, BB Stables, respected officers or members, horse show officials and staff, employees and agents shall not be responsible or liable for any injury, accident, damage, loss claims, or cost occasioned or suffered by a competitor, member of their agents, or for any other matter that may happen from any cause or circumstance or event whatever in connection with or arising out of or attributable to the show or any journey to or from the show.

Post Entries: Should be made at least 3 classes prior to entering the arena.

Class Awards: Ribbons to 6th place will be given.

Amateur Cards: Exhibitor must have either a WSH / USAE/ or Breed amateur card, which will be inspected at the show unless a photocopy is included with the entry. In Amateur Classes, a current USAE or WSH Amateur card is required, or application may be made with the show secretary at the time of picking up show numbers. WSH will issue Amateur Cards for an annual fee of \$15.00. If the applicant is a member of WSH and participating in the annual High Score awards competition there is no fee.

Registration Papers (copies please) must accompany entry and if horse is dual registered BOTH sets of papers must be submitted if entering a Breed classes.

Conduct: Show management reserves the right to refuse any entry or an exhibitor or the participant of any agent, trainer, or rider who has shown an objectionable attitude toward a recognized show or previous unsportsman like behavior at a recognized show or to its management. Show committee reserves the right to combine/cancel unfilled classes; accept entries of unfilled classes at a regular fee; divide classes as entries warrant. Exhibitors will be advised of combined, and cancelled/divided classes.

Age of an individual on December 1, 2007 is maintained the entire year. For horse show purposes, a horse becomes one year old on January 1 following the actual foaling date.

Exhibitors must appear in the ring suitably attired, with correct numbers clearly visible to the judge at all times, when in competition, entries with wrong or missing numbers will be disqualified. If an exhibitor voluntarily removes a horse from the ring without permission of the judge, the exhibitor may be disqualified from all future classes at the show by the show committee and forfeit all prizes and entry fees for the entire show.

Driving Directions to BB Stables:

From I5 north - take Exit 256A (Lynden / Sumas) on to Meridian St (hwy 539) heading north. Approx. 3 miles to Smith Rd turn right (towards Mt Baker) and stables are 1 mile on left.

HIGH POINT AWARDS –

There will be awards made for the series of shows (June 25 & Sept 14) to be eligible horse or rider must have competed at both shows. Plus the High points listed on the entry blank. To have your points count you must sign up for the daily Hi-point.

\$.50 of each entry will be donated to the NWBZ general fund.
